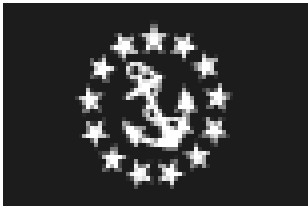

Vice Commodore's Report

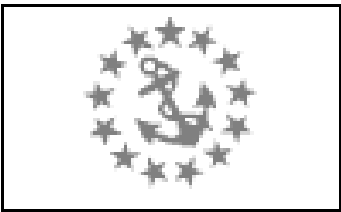


May is here and the boat are getting washed, waxed and launched. This month we have 3 exciting events planned that will get the boating season started and we are looking forward to seeing you all there.

Rear Commodore's Report



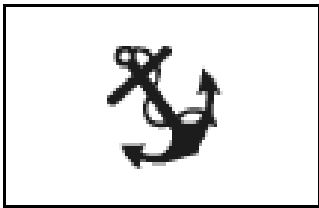
