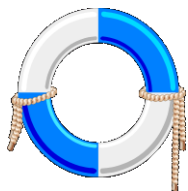




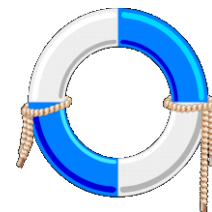

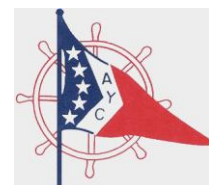

AYC- Log Report



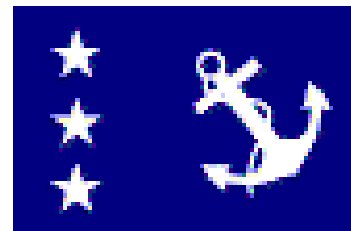

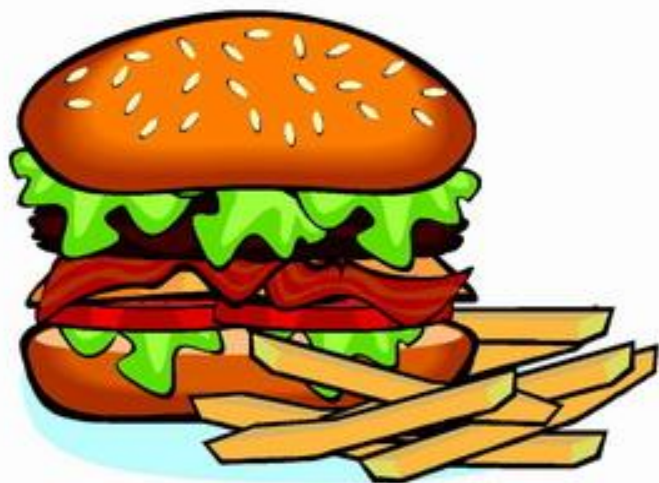

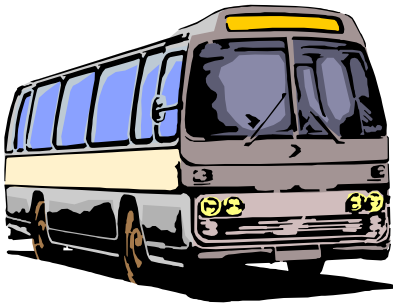
