Hello Everyone,

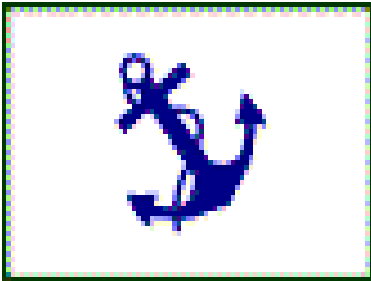

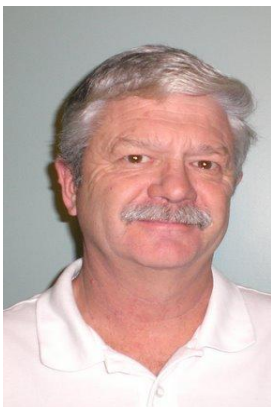

The election of the Bridge, except for the Immediate Past Commodore, shall take place at the annual membership meeting, which will take place in December in each year. Any individual who has been a member in good standing of this Corporation for at least one year may be considered for office. The nominating committee for selecting and presenting the slate of Flag Officers and Directors for the following year shall include the Commodore, Vice-Commodore, Immediate Past Commodore and two primary members at large and in good standing. Method of selection of the two primary members shall be determined by the current Flag Officers. Thirty days before the date set for the election, the nominating committee shall present a slate of candidates for office. The Secretary shall ensure that all members are notified in writing of the slate of candidates. In addition, any members, who otherwise qualify for office, may allow his or her name to stand in nomination, upon the filing with the Secretary at least 15 days prior to the date set for election of a consent to stand for office executed by that person and by two other members in good standing of the Corporation. In the event that any election for the same office results in an equal number of votes cast, the successful candidate shall be determined by a flip of the coin.
