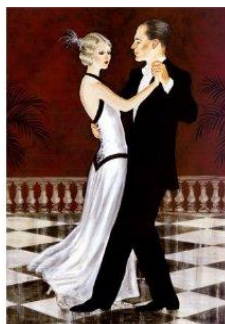

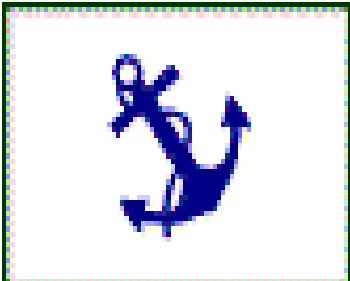


# Fleet Captain's Report
