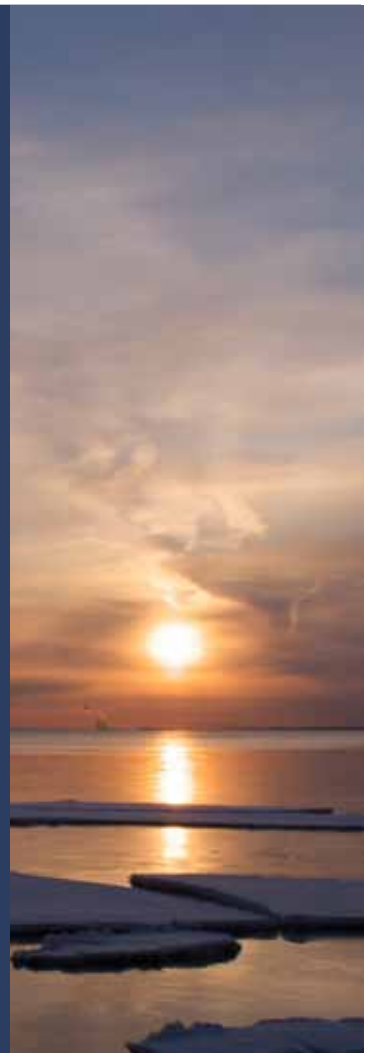

auxiliary report



membership report

This year after taking on the Membership position it was decided to evaluate the old paperwork. I found some interesting information. The oldest data goes back to 1992. In 1992 SPBC dues were \$70.00 and \$10.00 for an associate (first mate). Wives were not voting members. In 1995 the year started with 162 Primary memberships, 109 Associates and ended reaching the 200 maximum Primary, 128 Associates and 7 people on a waiting list wanting to become SPBC members. The boating world has changed so much.

The dues were increased for the 1996 year to \$90.00 Primary and \$10.00 Associate. The initiation fee also increased from \$25.00 to \$50.00 and I believe this was due to starting the capital fund.

In 2004 we had 155 and 2007 we dipped to 130 memberships. That year we had to start the work hours to get the help needed to run the club.

Looking at it now, our membership dues being \$150.00, including the capital fund, have not even doubled in 20 years.

Jeff Cowan had an "Early Bird Renewal" draw for a refund of the 2012 dues and it was a big success. The winner being, P/C Dave & Lucy Wright.

On that note I would like to remind those not having sent in their renewals by Feb 1st, they will be dropped from the SPBC Membership list and will need to reapply as NEW members in 2012. By the time you read this we will only have 3 months till Launch!
