

See you when we get home!!





What Is An AYC Poker Run?

An AYC Poker Run is a 5 part gift from the AYC to all of its members.


Each Member Club is given the chance to turn their Regatta into a Poker Run, meaning that they are open to receiving boats from all the different ports for the three day period, during which they provide food and drink at a reasonable cost along with entertainment in a carnival-like atmosphere. When you arrive, you are given a playing card and the person with the best poker hand at the last Poker Run (the Opening of the Cards) wins the pot which is a substantial amount with second and third prizes. Also, if you were at all of them, you get a flag that you can proudly display on your boat showing your committment toward being the supreme partier. Because of the attendance, all attendees are required to call ahead to reserve a slip for the weekend which is always free of charge, although, if you reserve late, you might find yourself as part of a raft, but, you will always get in.

For your convenience the flyer below has a list of all the Poker Runs for the 2023 season and all are encouraged to attend. There are prizes for the club with the most people at each event and so one person from our club keeps tabs on whoever goes from our group.
