Of course, there were a few couples that went far beyond the call, with countless hours of not only bartending, stocking and set up, but also listening to our crabbing and complaining....thank you.

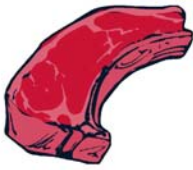
Finally, to all..... take a deep breath....have comfort in the fact that we, as a club, can hold our head high, and enjoy what's left of the season.

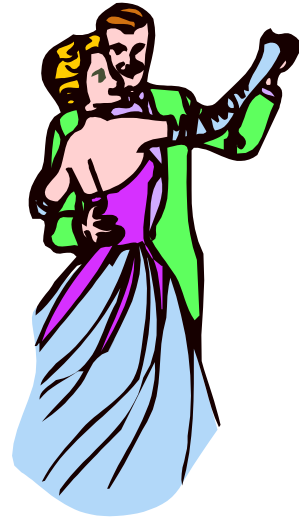

Mosquito Treatment
